



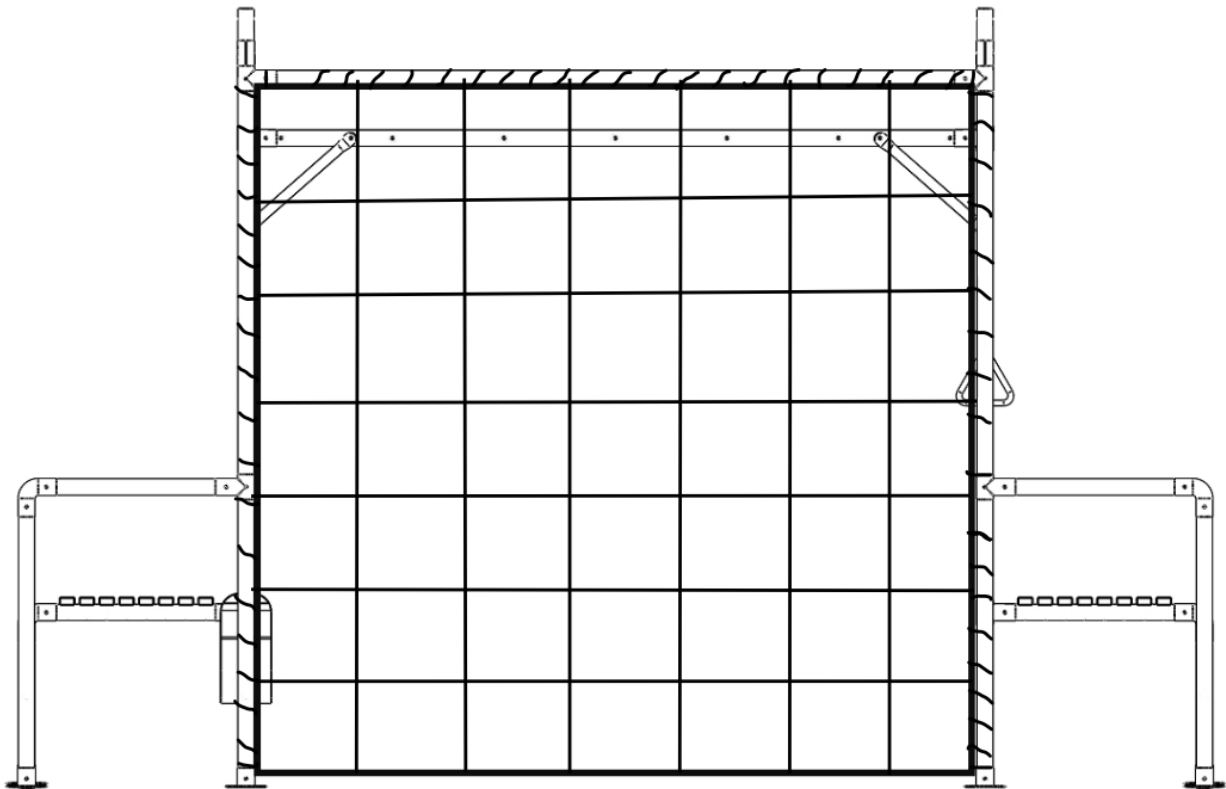

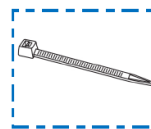
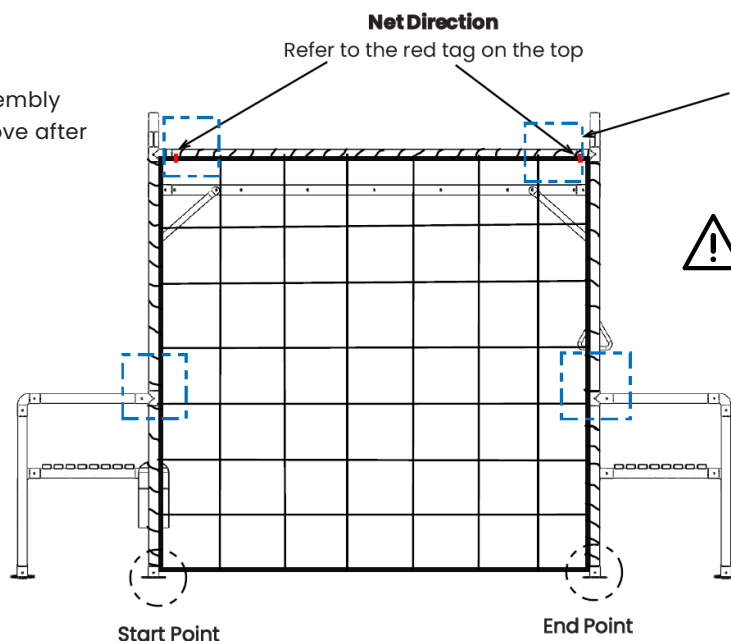
For the installer and your children's safety, it is important to fully read and understand the instructions and safety hazards before commencing the assembly of the product.

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

- Net X 1
- Rope X 1
- Zip Tie X 4 - For assembly assistance only, remove after fully installed.



WARNING: This is not a toy. Adult supervision is required at all times.

The cargo net is designed to be installed on the Junior Jungle Daylesford on the post between the 2x swing attachments.

1. Use the zip ties to hang the net into position. The red tag on the net needs to be at the top as pictured.
2. From the starting point, wrap the rope and the corner of the netting to the post and make a double knot.
3. Next wrap the rope from netting to the post all around until you reach the end point. Make a double knot to secure. Check both knots are fully tightened.
4. Remove the cable ties.

SAFETY WARNINGS

- Do not allow children to hang, swing excessively, or jump from the net.
- Choking hazard: Do not insert head into the netting.
- Ensure the frame is on a flat, stable surface with adequate clearance around the net.
- Confirm all knots, ropes, and attachment points are secure before each use.
- Remove the temporary zip ties after assembly—they are not load-bearing and must not remain during use.
- Avoid wearing loose clothing, hoodies, or items that may get caught in the net.
- Do not exceed the weight capacity: 50kg.
- Keep the area around and beneath the net free from hazards, furniture, or hard objects.
- Do not use the net in wet or slippery conditions as this may increase the risk of falls.
- Intended for domestic use only—not suitable for commercial or public playgrounds unless specified.

PROPER USE GUIDELINES

- Ensure children climb using both hands and feet, maintaining three points of contact at all times.
- Only one user should climb at a time to avoid entanglement or collisions.
- Regularly check the rope and net for signs of wear, looseness, or fraying.
- Replace damaged components immediately.
