

# **Recommended Torque Values for Nuts and Bolts**

Head Tube Quick Release	Tension Force < 200N.M Stripping Force > 50N.M
Seat Post Quick Release	Tension Force < 200N.M Stripping Force > 50N.M
Wheel Set	Locking Tension for Front Wheel Nut: 15-20N.M
	Locking Tension for Rear Wheel Nut: 15-20N.M

1. Inspect the bike and all included parts to make sure there are no damaged or missing parts.



3. Insert the handlebars into the handle bar stem. Adjust the handlebar height to so that it is suitable for the child. Take care not to exceed the maximum height indicator. Adjust, then lock the quick release.



5. Inspect the bike's functionality before use.

4. Insert the seat post into the seat tube. Adjust the seat to a height suitable for the child. Take care not to exceed the maximum height indicator. Adjust, then lock the quick release.
