

I. SAFETY AND MAINTENANCE INSTRUCTION

1. Assembling the Chair:

- Carefully follow the provided assembly instructions.
- Ensure all bolts, screws, and components are securely tightened.
- Regularly inspect the chair for loose or damaged parts.

2. Weight Limit:

- Adhere to the specified weight limit indicated by the manufacturer.
- Do not exceed the recommended weight capacity to avoid structural damage.

3. Proper Sitting Position:

- Sit squarely in the centre of the chair with your back against the backrest.
- · Adjust the chair height so that your feet rest flat on the floor, promoting proper posture.

4. Adjustments:

- Utilize the chair adjustments (height, tilt, and armrests) to suit your comfort and ergonomic needs.
- Do not force adjustments; if they are difficult, consult the user manual for guidance.

5. Regular Inspections:

- Periodically inspect the chair for any signs of wear, loose screws, or damaged components.
- Tighten any loose screws promptly, and replace any damaged parts.

6. Avoid Rough Handling:

- Do not lean back too forcefully or use excessive force when adjusting the chair.
- · Avoid dropping into the chair, as this can cause unnecessary strain on the structure.

7. Floor Surface:

- Place the chair on a stable and level surface.
- Use a chair mat on carpeted floors to prevent wear, and ensure the wheels move smoothly.

8. Cleaning and Maintenance:

- Clean the chair regularly with a mild detergent and a soft cloth.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners that may damage the chair's finish.
- Lubricate moving parts, such as wheel casters, as recommended by the manufacturer.

• Do not use the chair as a step stool or place heavy objects on it, as this may compromise its structural integrity.
