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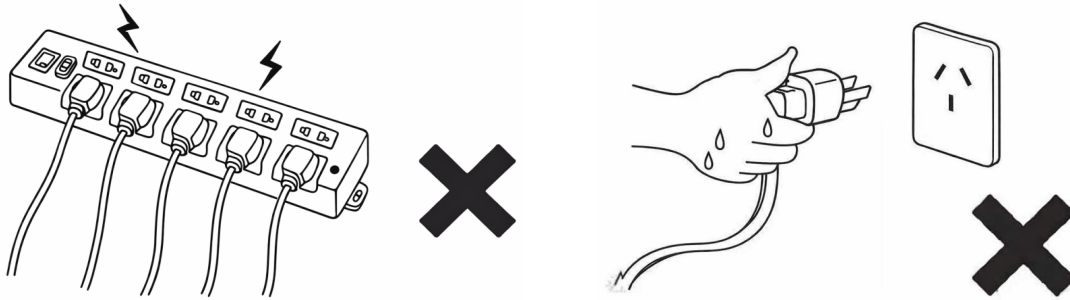
I. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Please read this manual carefully before use and keep it in a safe place.

This section contains important safety information to prevent personal injury and property damage. Please be sure to comply.

1.1 Safety Warnings

1. Do not plug or unplug the power plug with wet hands to avoid electric shock.



2. Use a dedicated, properly grounded power outlet. Do not share the outlet with other high-power appliances to prevent overload and fire hazard.

3. Unplug the power cord during thunderstorms.

4. Always unplug the power cord before cleaning, moving the unit, or when not in use for an extended period.

5. Do not allow children, persons with reduced capabilities, or inexperienced persons to operate the device without supervision.

6. Do not disassemble, repair, or modify the unit by yourself. All maintenance must be performed by qualified professionals.

7. Do not put fingers, hair, or any objects near or into the air vents while the unit is operating.

1.2 Operating Environment Requirements

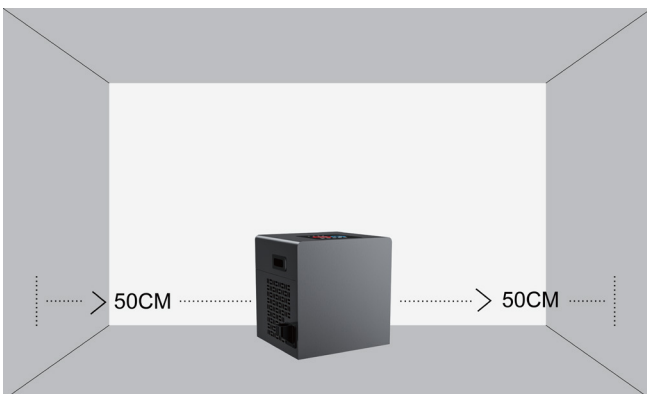
1. Place the unit on a stable, level surface.

2. Ensure at least 50cm of clearance around the unit for proper ventilation and heat dissipation.

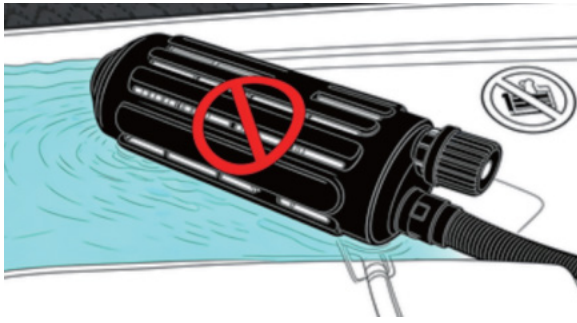
3. Do not install the unit in a cabinet, narrow space, or in environments with high temperature, high humidity, direct sunlight, or heavy grease fumes.

4. The recommended ambient temperature range for operation is 1°C to 40°C.

5. If the ambient temperature may drop below 0°C, be sure to drain all water from the internal pipes after use to prevent freezing damage.



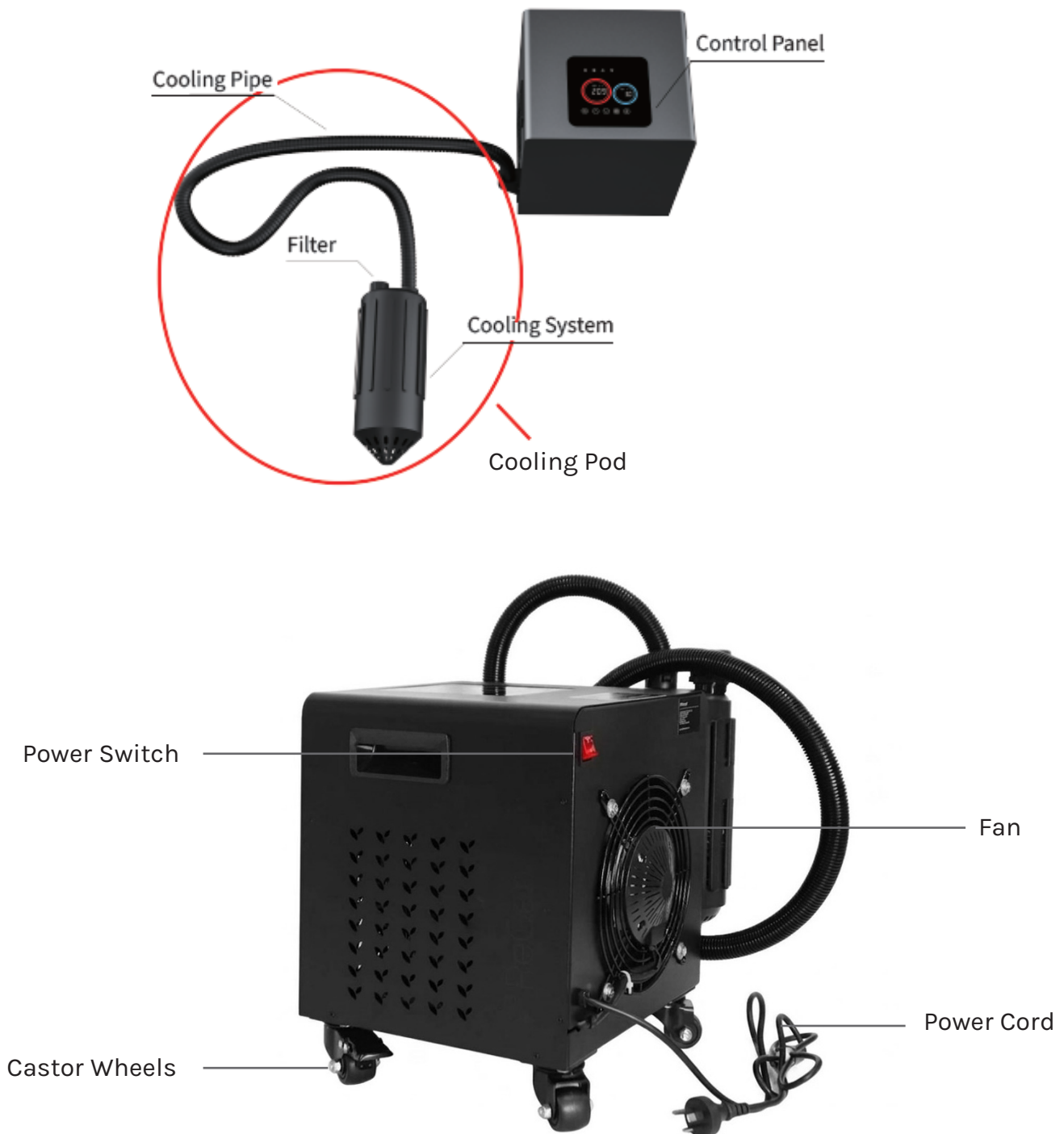
Operating Environment



1. Before entering the bathtub, please turn off the power and remove the "Cooling Pod" from the water. Hang it on the designated dock on the chiller.
2. Before starting the unit, ensure the water level in the bathtub completely submerges the "Cooling Pod part". Do not run the pump dry.
3. The Cooling Pod contains refrigerant. Do not pull, twist, drop, step on, or sit on it.
4. After transportation, let the unit stand upright for at least 24 hours before powering on to allow the refrigerant to settle.

3.1 Installation Steps

1. Fix the plastic clamps to the edge of your ice bath.



2. Secure the cooling pipes into the installed clamps.



3. Place the chiller on a stable surface near the ice bath with good ventilation.



4. Ensure 2 front castor wheels are locked in place before using the product

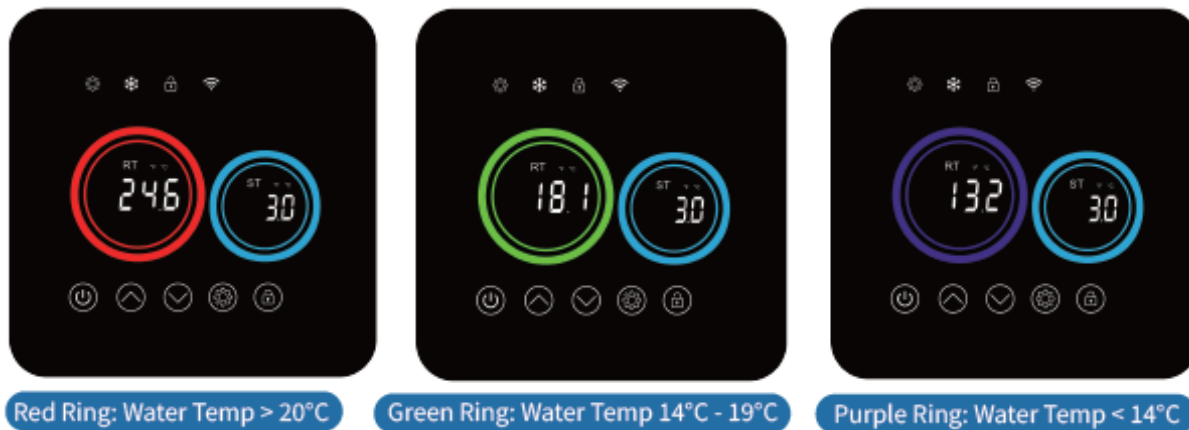

Set Temperature	1. Press the Set button 2. Press ▲ or ▼ to adjust 3. Settings auto-save after 5s
Lock Screen	Press and hold the Lock button
Compressor Status	Snowflake Icon 1.Flashing=Delayed start 2.Solid=Running

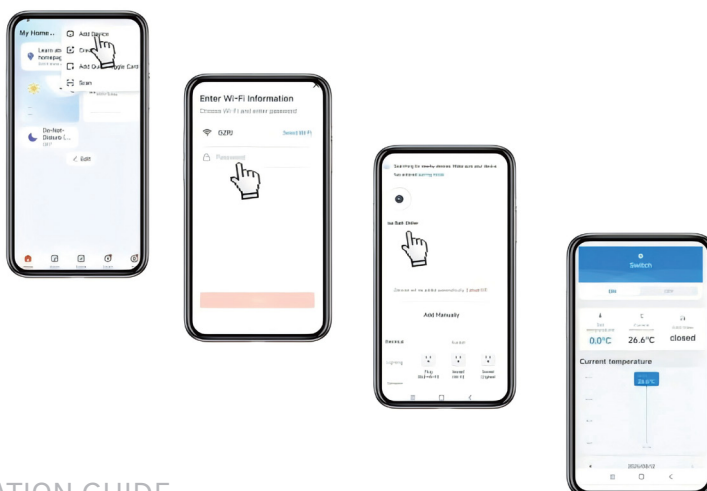

Scan the QR code and download the Tuya /Smart Life app.

Turn on Bluetooth and Wi-Fi on your phone.

Connect the chiller's power cord. After plugging it in, switch on the power switch at the back of the machine. When the controller displays "OFF", press and hold the ▲ and ▼ buttons simultaneously. Release them when "---" starts flashing.

Open Tuya / Smart Life, tap the "+" icon in the top-right corner of the app, and select "Add Device". Follow the app instructions: choose your Wi-Fi network, enter the password, and complete the setup. Each chiller can only be operated by one mobile phone.



V. CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

1. Before cleaning and maintenance, make sure you have unplugged the power plug.
2. Please use a clean and absorbent soft cloth to wipe the top cover, body and other parts to keep the appearance clean. (Note: Please do not wipe the operation panel, plug and power cord with a wet soft cloth).
3. Do not use corrosive liquids or abrasive objects to clean the product, such as detergents, gasoline, solvents, or hard brushes.
4. Do not allow water to enter the chiller.. Please do not soak the chiller in water for cleaning.
5. Remove and clean the Cooling Pod filter every 1-2 weeks to prevent clogging.



VI. TROUBLESHOOTING INSTRUCTIONS

Fault	Possible Causes	Solution
Not Working	Power not connected	Check and connect power
	Compressor 3-minute delay	Wait 3 minutes and retry
Water won't cool down	Ambient temperature too high (>40°C)	Move unit to a cooler, ventilated area
	Insufficient clearance around unit	Ensure ≥50cm space around unit
	Ice bath overfilled	Reduce water volume or upgrade to higher capacity chiller
Wet floor	Condensation dripping	Wipe condensation from bathtub and pipe surfaces
